“Consists of materials created by the Town of Jasper Place between 1949 and 1965.” The City of Edmonton Archives provides finding aids that list contents of boxes and files in each of the Series.
 - The following Series have been most consulted for background research and supporting documents for posts on the website to date:
 - Series 2 – Jasper Place Recreation Commission
Some of the files consulted included: Jasper Place Sports Centre Committee; Jasper Place Sports Centre Operational Annual Report, Finances, Licensing; Recreation Commission Scrapbooks.

- **Series 3 – Office of the Secretary Treasurer**
Examples of files consulted: Box 9: Jasper Place Annexation statistics / financial and statistical data, special report on Jasper Place Schools, census; Box 12: Royal Commission on Metropolitan Development of Calgary and Edmonton, September 1954, includes a Brief Submitted to the Royal Commission by the Town of Jasper Place; Boxes 17 and 18: Subdivisions maps and files on developers; Box 20: Jasper Place Chamber of Commerce resolutions.
There is much more research to be carried out in this Series.
 - **Series 6 – Council Minutes**
The Town of Jasper Place Council Minutes were only indexed between 1959 and 1964. Therefore, to look for items discussed and decisions taken before then, it is necessary to read through the minutes file-by-file and meeting-by-meeting. Subject areas requiring this detailed research included: plebiscite on allowing liquor in Jasper Place; the sign featuring the “Young Giant”; discussions, decisions and the eventual bylaw on closing hours specific to Jasper Place.
 - **Series 9 – Bylaws**
We have consulted many bylaws on the finding aid, and have requested a formal copy of Bylaw #184, “Closing By-Law”.
